

**[Press Release]****DelSolar Co., Ltd. Moving Towards the Goal of Reaching 840MW Total Capacity with Construction Commencement Ceremony for Its New LEED- and EEWH-Qualified Plant**

DelSolar Co., Ltd. (3359) held a construction commencement ceremony for its proposed plant in the newly developed Lung-Tan area of Hsin-Chu Science-Based Park this morning. The new plant is expected to be completed by the fourth quarter of next year and start production soon thereafter. As planned, the total capacity of the new plant should reach 720MW. Coupled with the existing plant in the Science Park, DelSolar's total capacity can reach 840MW.

DelSolar's Chairman and CEO, Mr. R.C. Liang, said, "Having inherited Delta Group's corporate vision to 'love the Earth by way of environmental protection and energy conservation', DelSolar designed the new plant with Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (also known as "LEED") criteria provided by USGBC and Ecology, Energy Saving, Waste Reduction, Health (also known as "EEWH") provided by Ministry of the Interior of the Republic of China in mind. The design integrates the office building with the manufacturing plant. By the time the new plant is completed, it will be the first LEED-and EEWH-qualified green building owned by a solar energy company in the Science Park."

The deputy manager of the Science Park Management Office, Mr. Liang-Sheng Tung, was also present at the ceremony and said, "DelSolar is able to achieve 120MW with its existing plant. In the future, the new plant will be able to achieve 720MW on this 2.1-acre land, which is very impressive. DelSolar ranked No. 23 in Business Today's top 100 pre-IPO companies in terms of diluted earnings per share in 2007 and No. 10 in the top 50 fastest growing companies in Tian-Xia Magazine's survey of 1000 manufacturing companies in 2007. It is foreseeable that the green energy industry will become a 22-trillion New Taiwan Dollars ("NTD") industry by 2016. Further, European Union has also announced that the total volume of CO<sub>2</sub> emission in 2020 should be reduced to the level in 1990, and the renewable energy should make up 20% of the total energy usage by 2020. Currently, solar energy constitutes less than 1% of the total power generation in the world. The entire solar energy industry still has a very bright future ahead." Mr. Tung also expected that solar energy industry can grow into another trillion NTD industry in Taiwan, and that DelSolar can

become the leading company in this industry.

Currently DelSolar's actual capital is 1.18 billion NTD. In 2007, its net profit after tax is 620 million NTD. Diluted Earnings per share were NTD 7.01 for 2007 and NTD 3.18 for the first half of 2008.
